From the very beginning of his life, Ryan brought a sense of fun and mischief into the House family. His father was so proud to have a son, and they shared a close, special bond throughout his life.

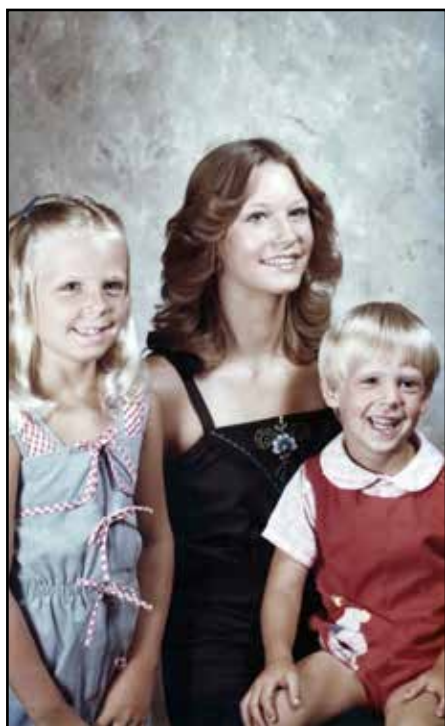

He is preceded in death by his father, Jack House.









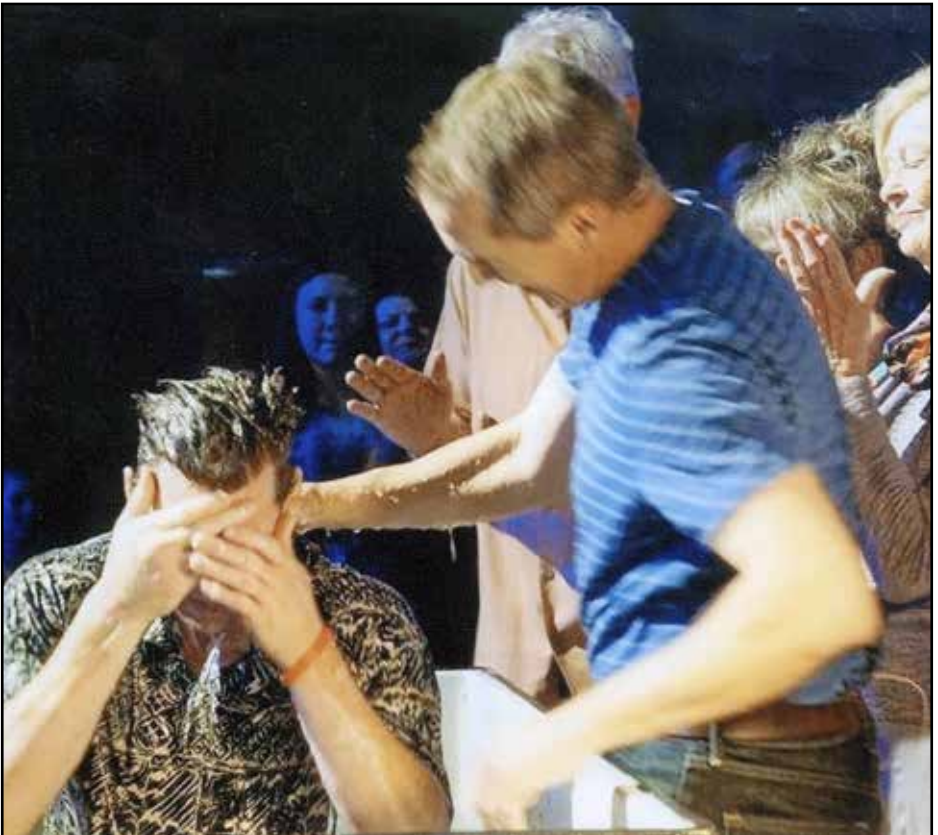






The Serenity Prayer
