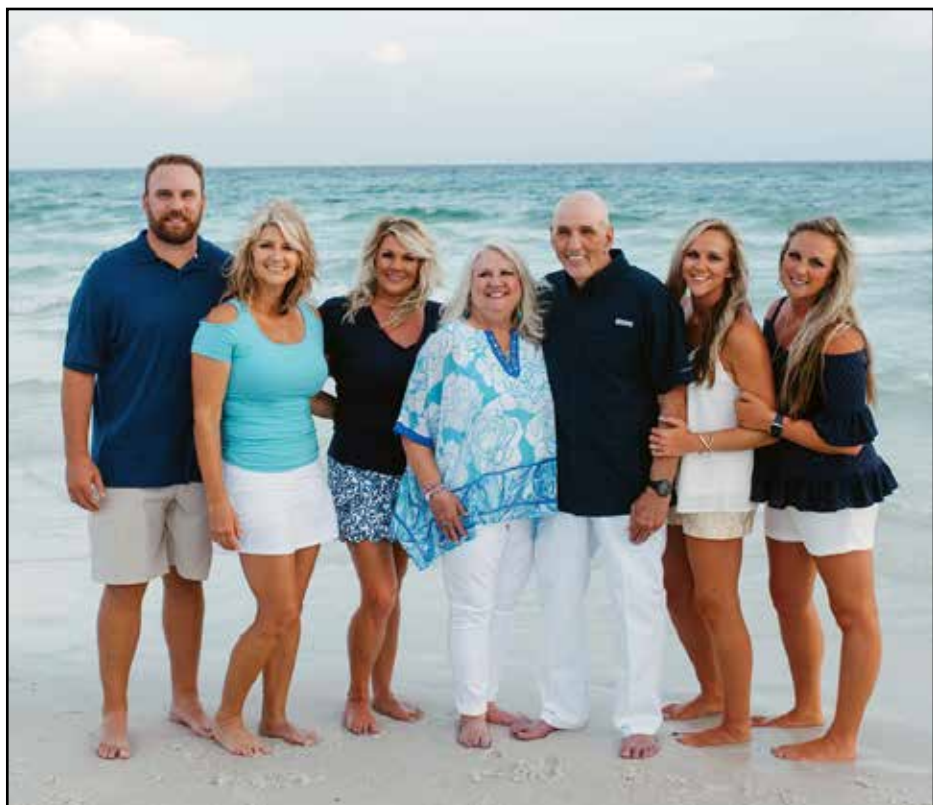

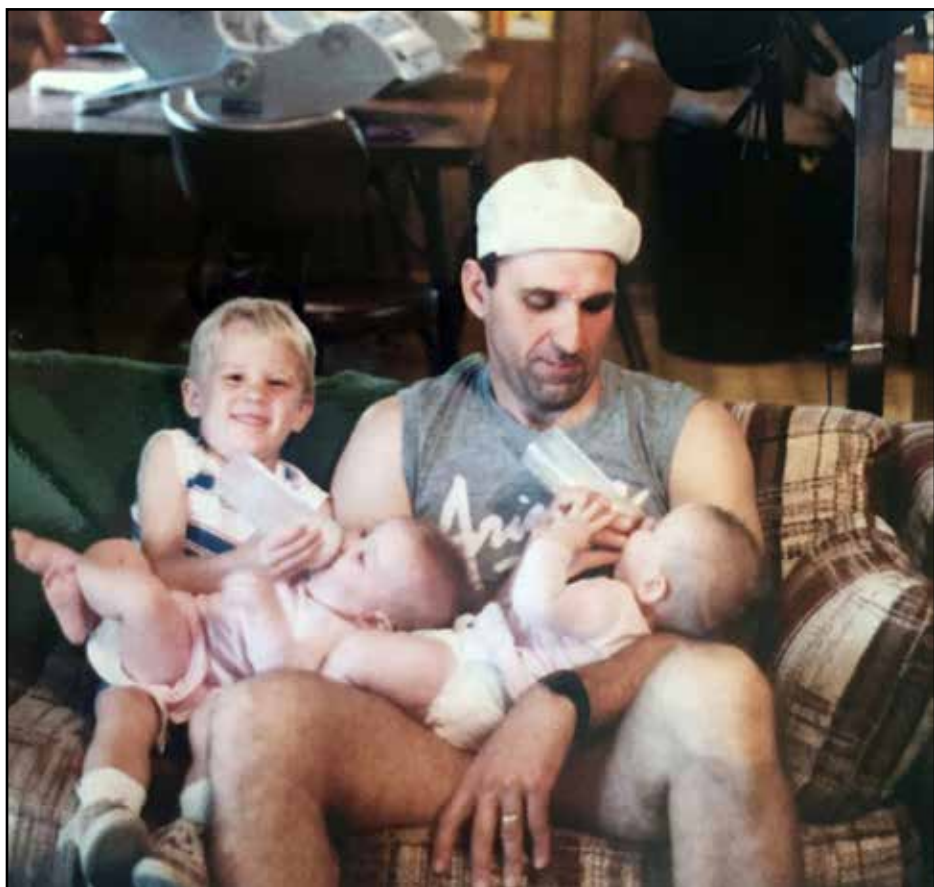
He is preceded in death by his parents, Maudie Josephine and James Fred; and his infant brother, Jerry Glynn.
