Catholic and a faithful member of St. Louis Catholic Church in Winnie.

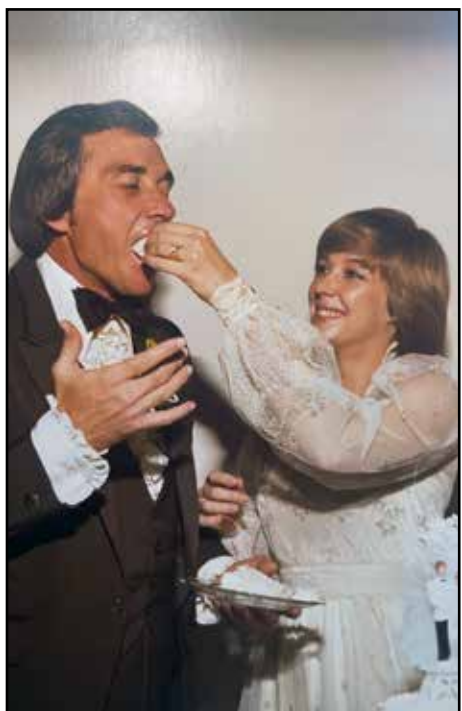

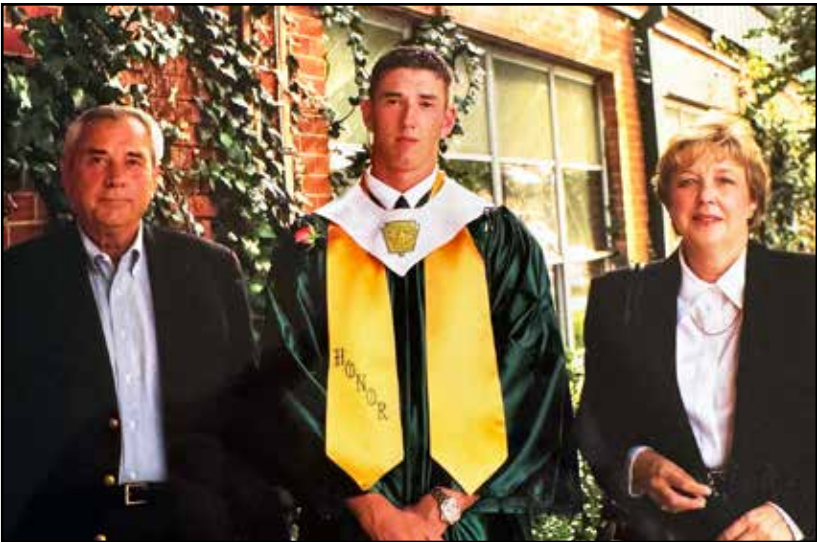
