Take the tractor around one more turn.*

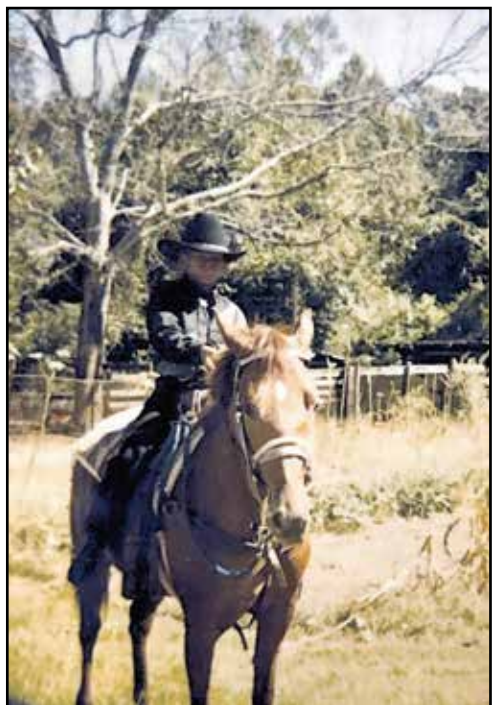
*For the prayer of rain has been answered

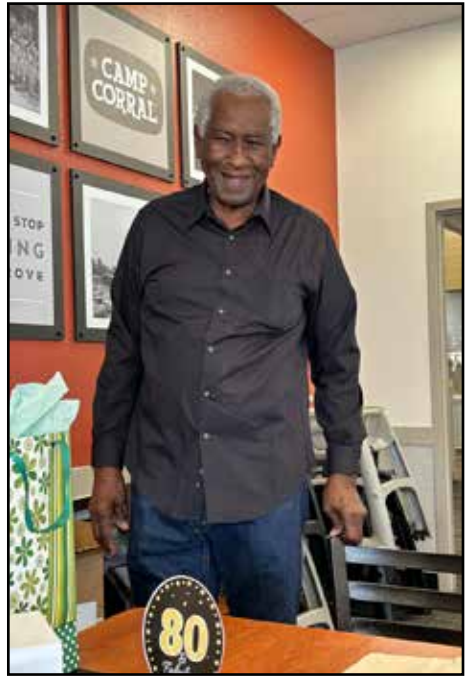
