He was a loving devoted father, husband and friend. Mark was selfless and always putting others before himself and was a man of honor.

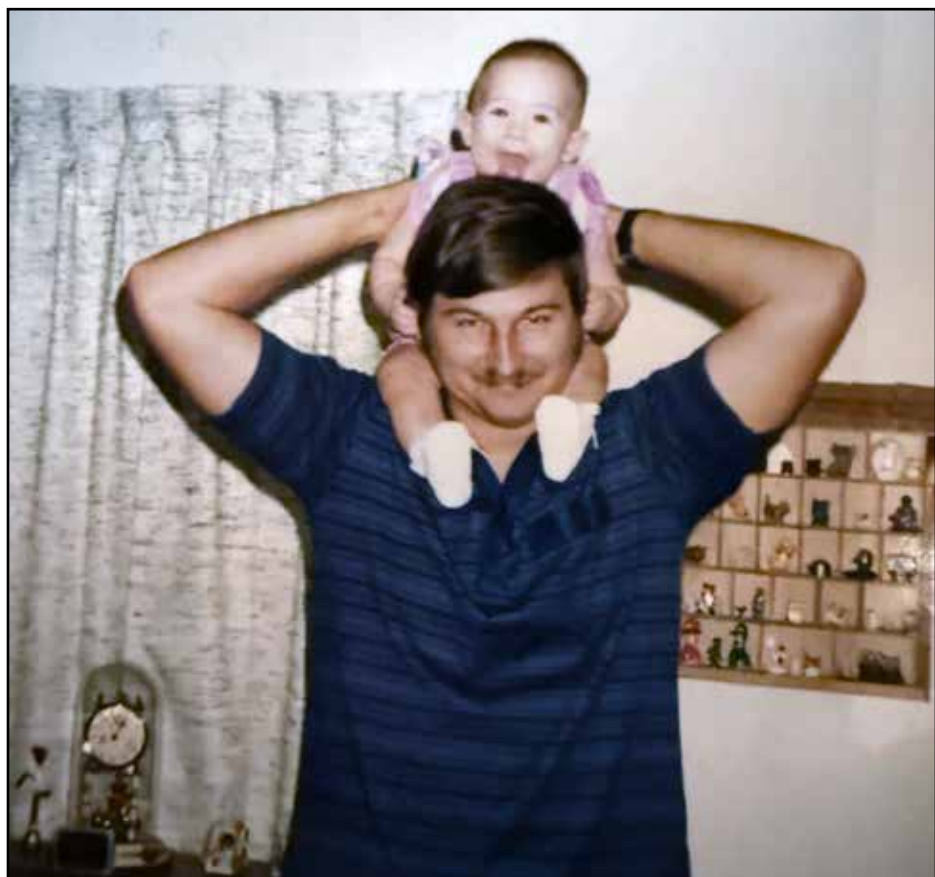
He had a successful electrical contracting business he started himself when he was thirty years. Mark drew plans and built his home in Lumberton himself at twenty-four years old.

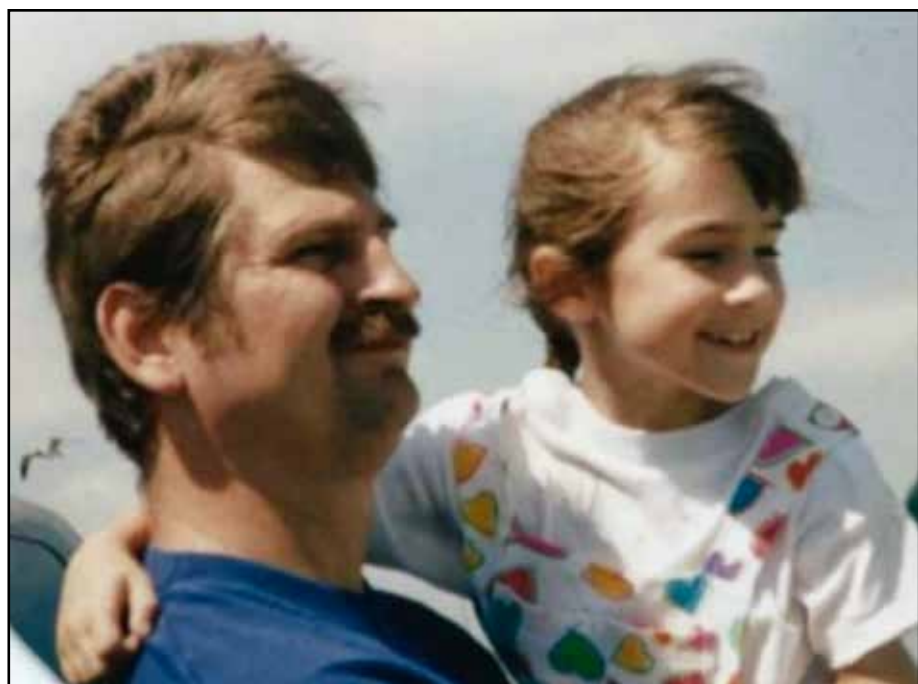
