He was a TV and movie fanatic. Sci-fi, Japanese Anime, and thrillers gave him hours of pleasure.

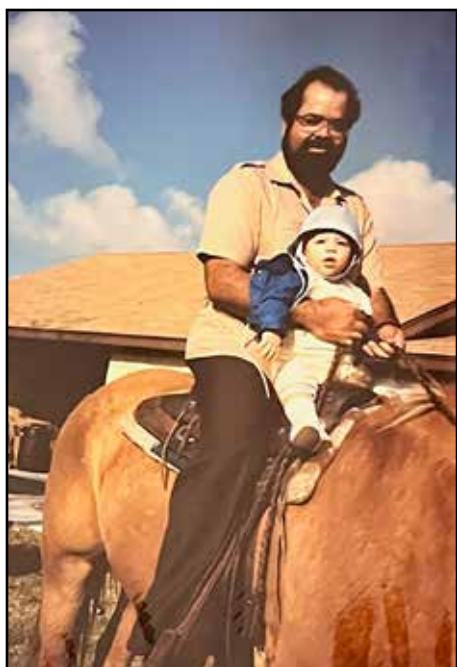

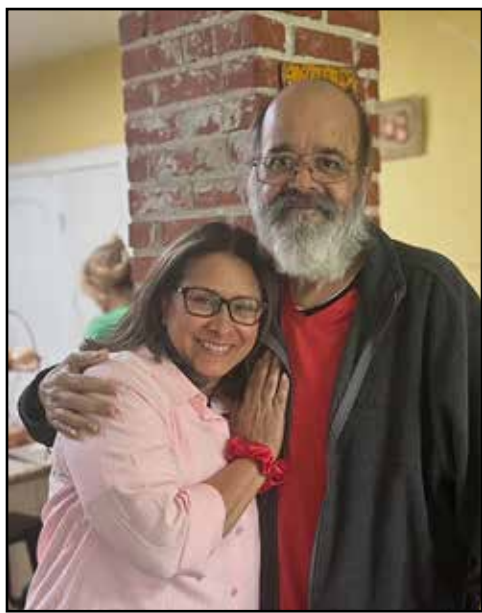
