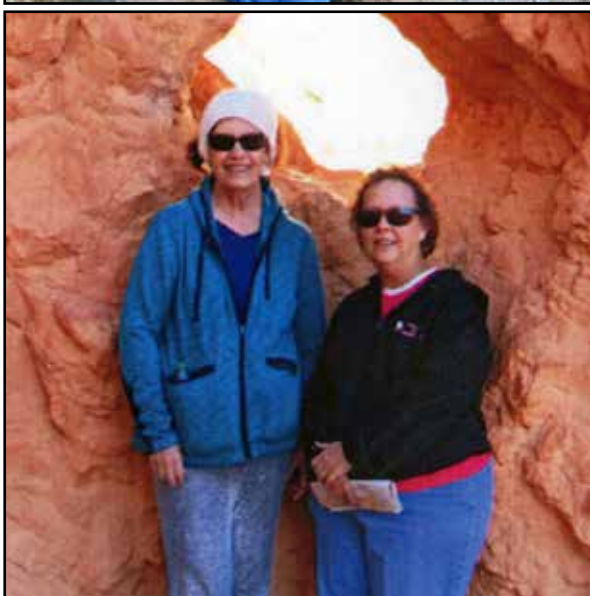

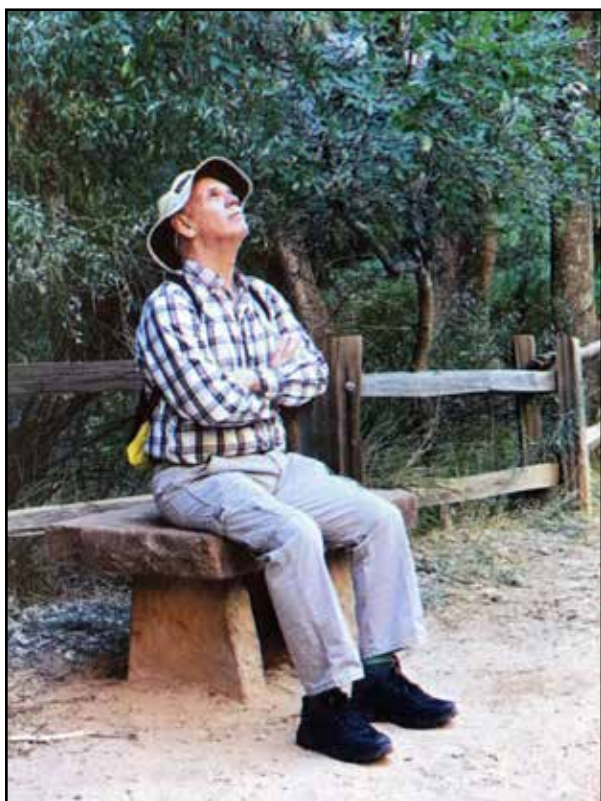
She is preceded in death by her parents; grandson, Nehemiah Stager; sister, Jean Long; and nephews, James and Dale Long.

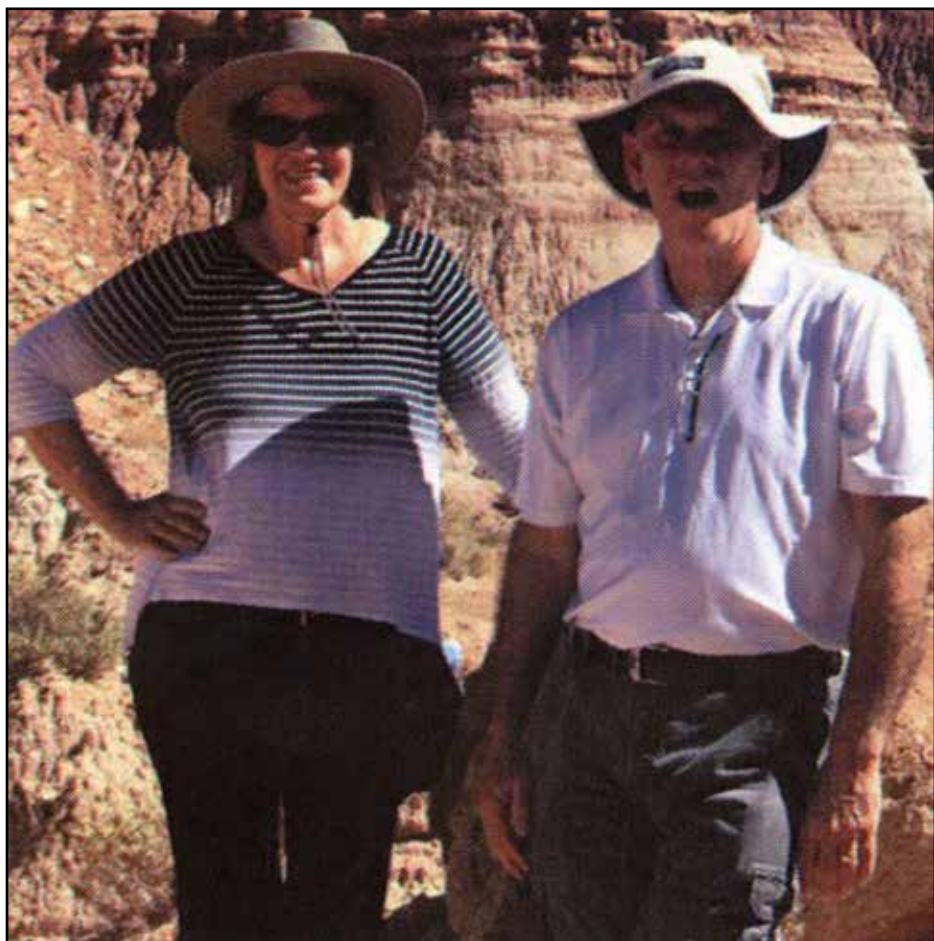
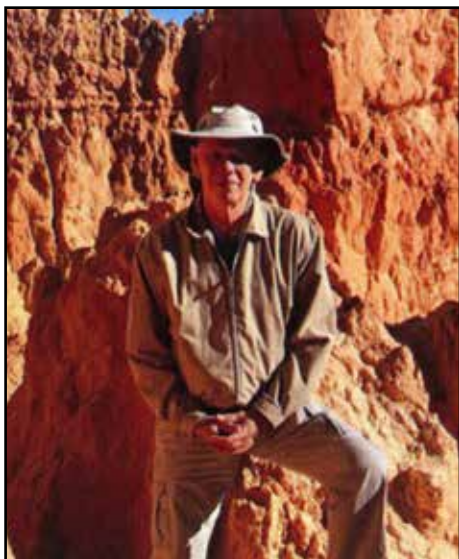
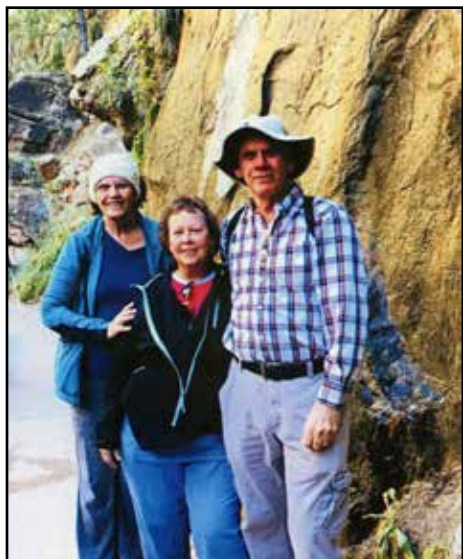






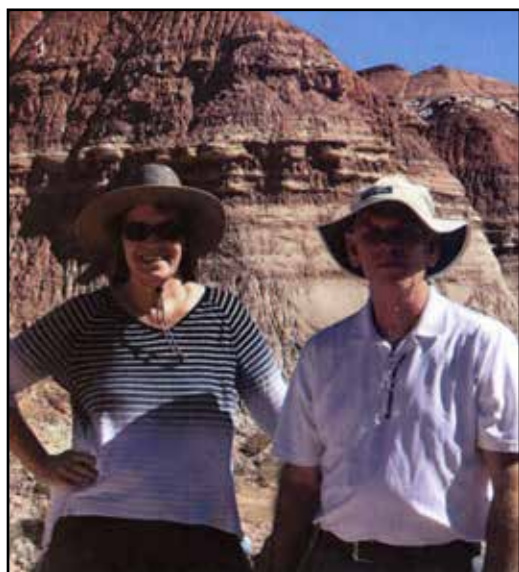
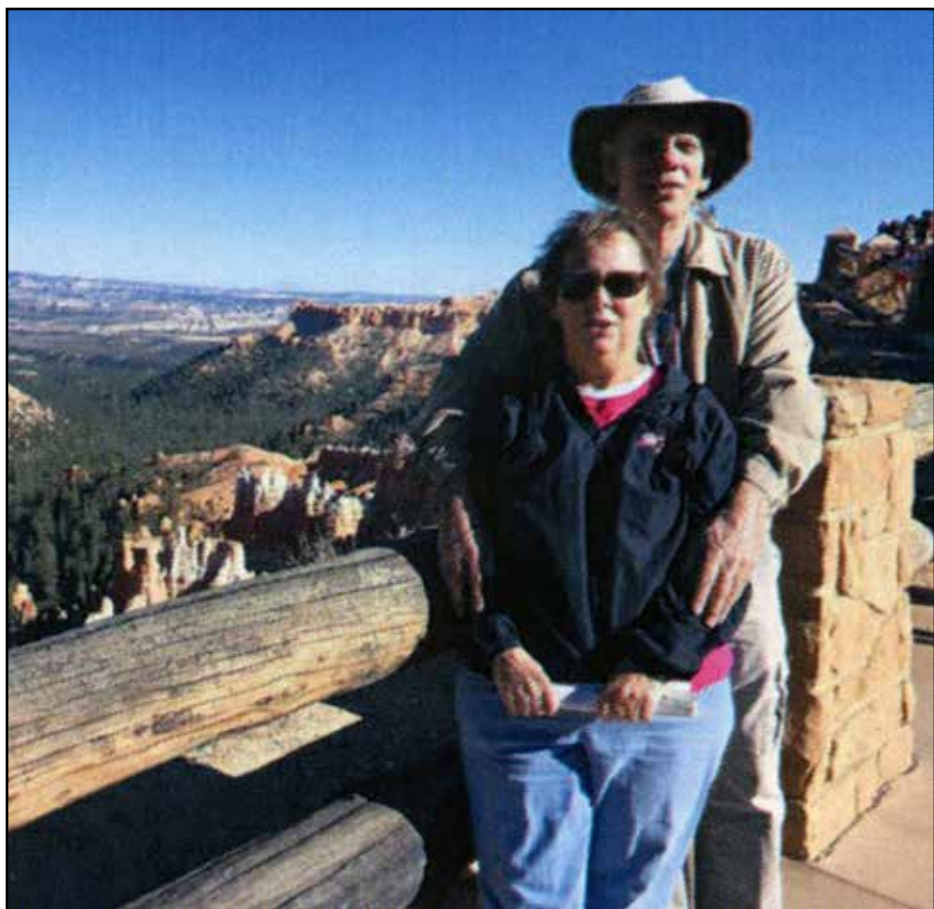






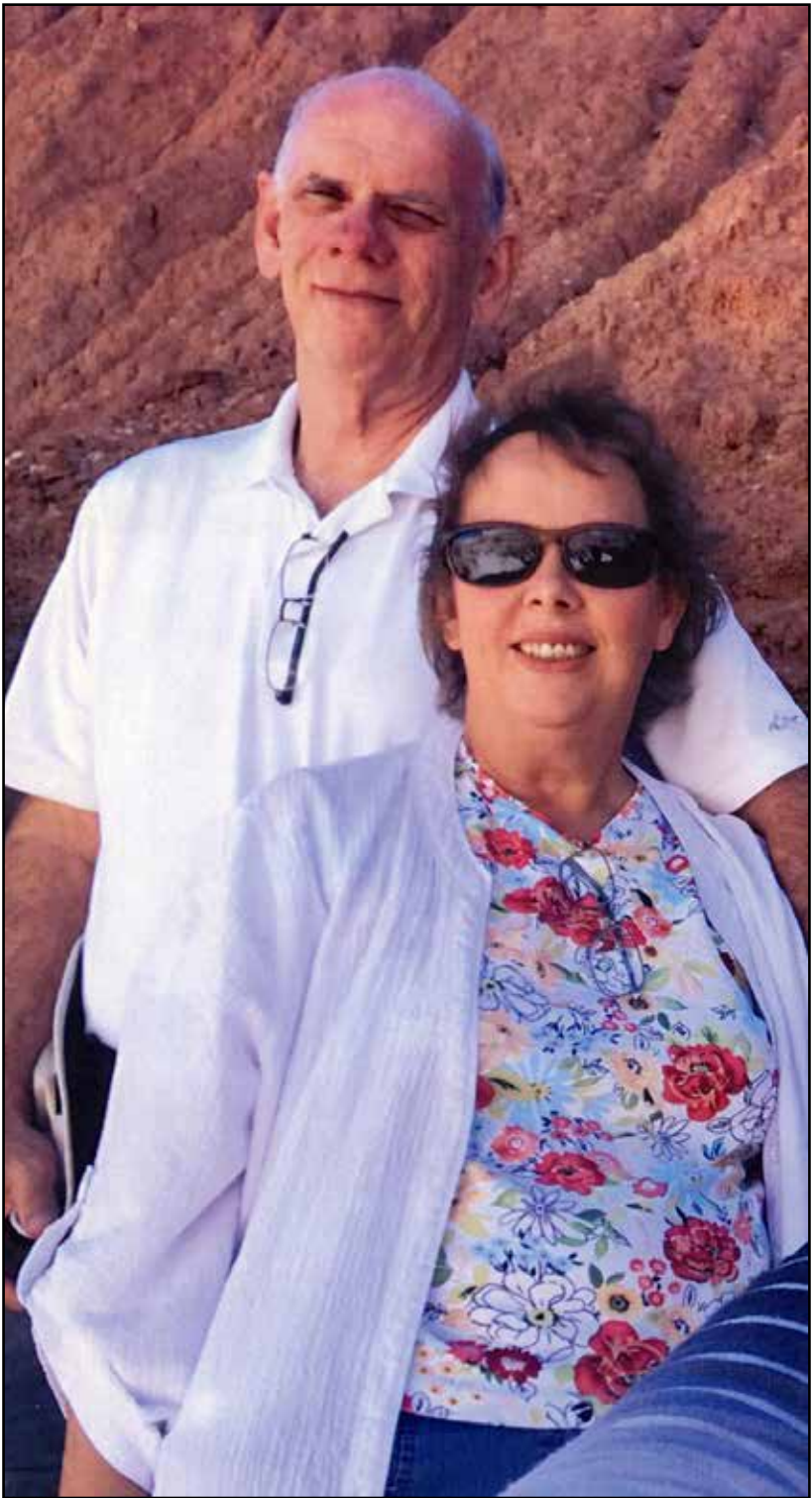
