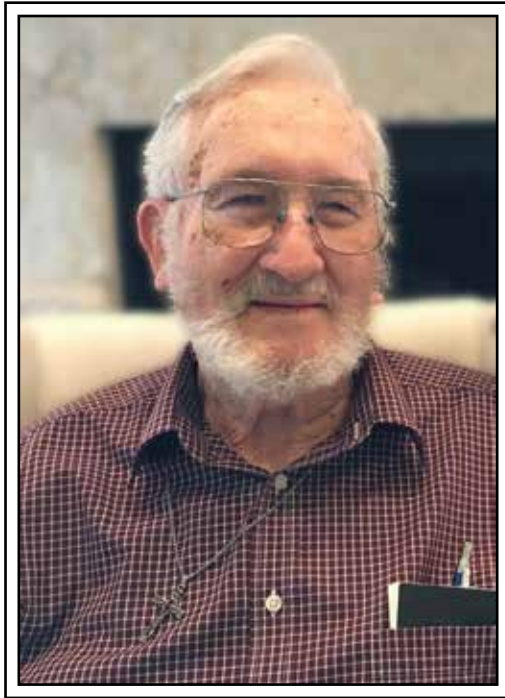


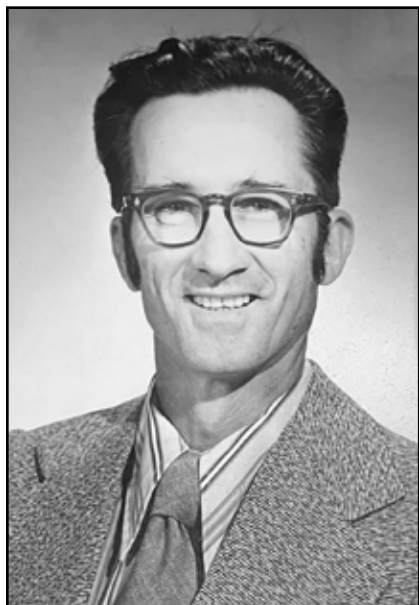

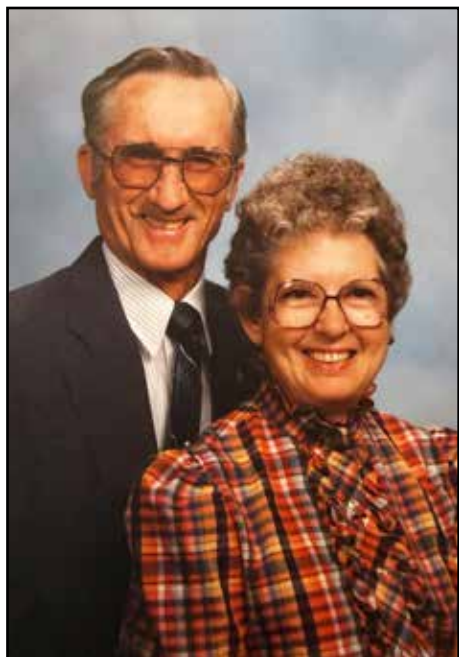
He is preceded in death by 7 siblings; son, Hank Kaspar; and grandson, George Gilliland.
