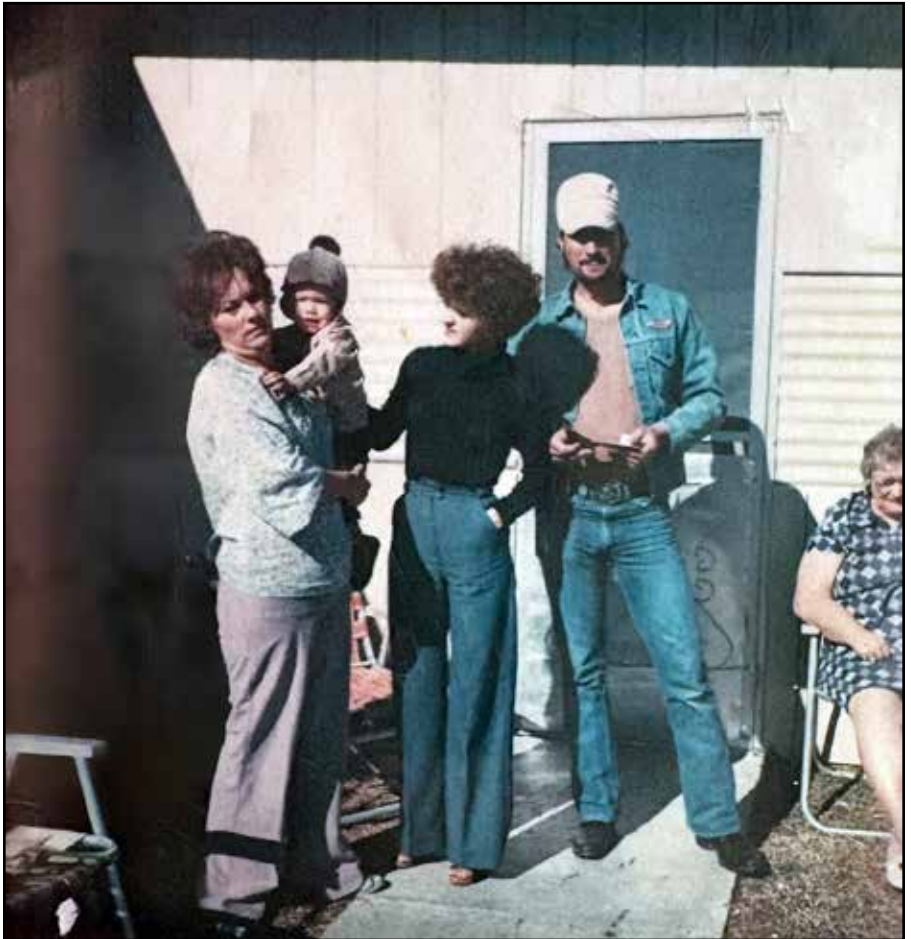

He loved his best bud, Brantly.

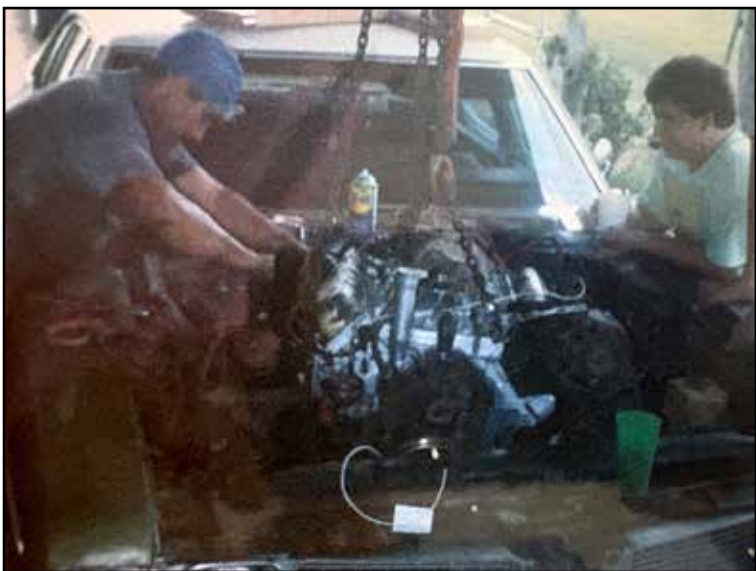

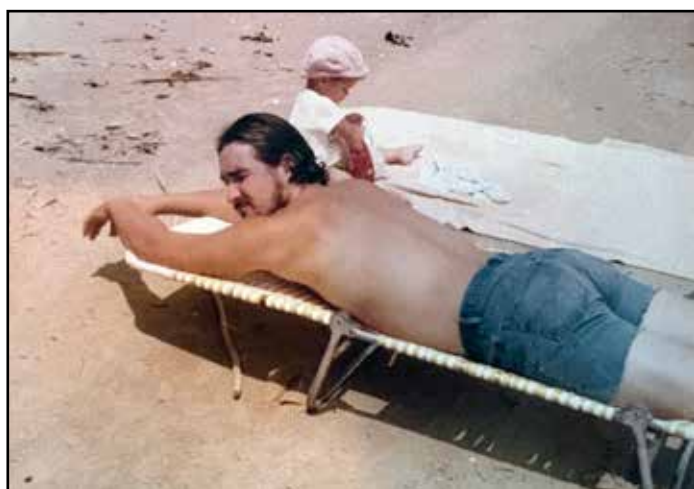
Donald is preceded in death by his parents and daughter, Miranda Maria Leonard.
